SALIENT FEATURES OF THE YEAR

- The students of Veer Abhimanyu Balshakha were taken to Ambawde Village; on the farm house of Shri. Datta Deodhar. They were first time visiting a farm. They talked to the farmers over there. They were very curious to know the tools the farmers use; their names and usage. They observed how the farming is done, various development stages of the crop and the chain of activities the farmers are required to do daily, in the open field. All of them enjoyed the visit & full day stay.
After this visit an exhibition was arranged wherein the pictures drawn by the students and some hard paper models were exhibited. Some students wrote their experiences. The parents were impressed while observing this exhibition.
- The volunteers of Ramkrishna Shakha met one of the retired military officer namely Captain Shri.Dinkar Pawar, who is running 80, on the Republic day. The wardhaks respectfully bowed before him for his service to the Nation. Shri.Pawar shared his experiences in the wars from 1962 to 1971 against China and Pakisthan. The students were highly motivated by this visit.
- Sathe Foundation is helping the trust in many ways since past many years. This year the trust donated 100 books for the library of Wardhine.
- The youth wing of the trust goes on a cycle trek every alternate year. This year the cycle trek was arranged to visit the Raigad Fort; 350 Km from Pune. 40 Youth volunteers successfully completed the trek
- The Senior Group of Pakoli Montessori were taken to visit a farm house at Shilim. The kids liked the atmosphere in the open field. They visited the farm, a nearby poultry. Some of the kids played with chickens. Then they were taken to a brick manufacturing unit. They observed the process of making bricks from mud. They asked questions to the workers. The thing they most liked was their lunch in tents. The lunch with cool breeze coming into the tents made them very happy. Some of the kids expressed their wish to stay overnight in the tent.
- Jointly with Shri. Dhondumama Sathe Homeopathy Medical College, Wardhinee started a Homeopathy OPD in Wardinee. The OPD was inaugurated at the hands of Chairman of Wardhinee Shri.Ramesh Joshi. Vaidya Smt.Manisha Solanki and her two colleagues are running this OPD once a week. The response to this OPD is quite encouraging.
- On 1st March, 2011 a special guest lecture was arranged for the MPSC & UPSC students in Pune. The Guest lecturer was Shri.Anna Hazare; the crusade man who fought for the Right to Information Act as well as the "Jan Lokpal Bill"
The topic was "Administration and People's Right" The hall and the Varandha of Jnanaprabodhinee Upasana Mandir was heavily crowded by students. Shri. Anna Hajare addressed the gathering on the main topic and gave some important tips to the 'Tomorrow's Govt. Officers'. He said if you wish to succeed then you must have a -
 - Spotless character
 - Clean Practices & Usages
 - devotion
 - capacity to digest insults

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- A seminar was organized in the month of April on the topic 'Threats to the acceptance of Marathi Medium and the measures to overcome the same'. Principals of many primary schools attended and participated in the seminar. An audience of more than 100 teachers, social workers were present.
- For their demand of Janlokal Bill, veteran social worker Shri. Anna Hajare started his agitation at Delhi by observing Fast unto death. To support his demands a candle march was organized by citizens of Pune. Wardhinee participated in this candle march.
- In order to mount pressure on Central Govt. to correct the wrong action of arresting Shri. Anna Hajare & to start dialogue with him another candle march and dharna programmes were organized nationwide. Wardhinee also organised a procession march to support.
- To celebrate the successful fast unto death by Anna Hazare, a spontaneous and grand candle march started from Balgandharv Chowk. Wardhinee participated in the march with a big group of students from MPSC and Study Centre.
- The Chief trustees of Keshav Sanskar Varg, (Surat) Smt. Beenaben Rao had planned to run near about 100 sanskar Kendras during the summer vacation, with the help of college students. The response from the youth was overwhelming but they needed some training. Beenaben contacted Wardhinee for arranging such training. A team of four Wardhinee volunteers including Shri.Dnyanesh Purandare & Smt.Pushpa Nade conducted the training programme.
- Trekking is one of the attractions of the students and the volunteers. Visiting various forts on the periphery of Pune District is most attractive programme for all. However, while visiting such forts, the students and volunteers develop relations with villagers residing in the periphery. One of such spot is Rareshwar where Shiv Chatrapati took oath of 'Swaraj'. The volunteers observed that students and youth from the nearby areas are interested in Computer training, but they don't have any computers. The youth volunteers decided to donate two computers to them and start their computer literacy programme. In the month April, two computers were handed over to the trustees of Rareshwar Pratisthan.
- On 20th March, a full day meeting of project heads and senior volunteers was held at Jaldarshani, near Khadkwasla dam. It was held mainly for yearly planning and finalizing targets for every project. The targets finalized were announced in the Warsharambh Upasana on the auspicious day Gudhipadwa.
- The founder of the trust Shri.Krishnaji Laxman alias Kishabhau Patwardhan passed away in 2004. After his sad demise, the trustees and the volunteers decided to publish a book depicting his characteristics, the unforgettable moments which he spent with students, volunteers etc. An appeal was made to all concerned. A book titled "Aathwanitil Kishbhau" was published on 15th May,2011 at the hands of renowned Marathi writer Shri.Da.Ma.Mirasdar.
- Forts are our historical heritage and protection of these forts is the true responsibility of the society at large. Unfortunately, when the students /volunteers visit forts, it gives pain to see garbage all over the fort. Every year 1st May is celebrated as "Durg Raksha Din". Wardhinee participates in this. This year on this day, students visited various forts like

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Sinhgad, Visapur, Lohgad, Shivneri. They cleaned the ponds on these forts, collected plastic and other garbage on the forts. They requested the visitors to co-operate to maintain the cleanliness of Forts.

- A Health Awareness Programme was held at Bhagini Nivedita Shakha during the period 2nd July to 26th July, 2011. This was organized by the Dept. of Public Health Awareness of Pune University, under the leadership of Smt. Anjelin Jaykumar and Devaki Gokhale. The wardhika had to undergo various tests during the period. On the last day of the awareness programme the parents were called for a meeting. The team leader explained to the parents about the tests they conducted and their findings. The low percentage of B-12 was a common deficiency found in all the wardhikas. Mrs. Anjelin Jaykumar urged the parents and the students to follow the instructions given to overcome the deficiency. Dr. Sultana Begum who is a representative of W.H.O. for Bangladesh, visited Nivedita Shaka along with Dr. Anjelin Jaykumar to know more about the project.
- When lacs of Warkari touch the soil of Pune City, on their way to Pandharpur, the total atmosphere of Pune City becomes holistic. Many schools have holiday, as the school premises are given to the Warkaris for their temporary stay. This is an opportunity to know this 350 year old tradition. Students go to the schools to meet the Warkari, they offer the services that are needed by them. Most of them need some massaging. Students of two shakhas offered this service to them. This year, the students of Bhagini Nivedita Shakha collected 100 caps and 50 towels and gifted them to Warkaris in nearby schools. The medical college students of our self study centre arranged a medical check-up programme. 300 warkari were benefited. They were also given instructions to maintain good health.
- The incharge of Mobile Laboratory project Shri. Sunil Kulkarni has been helping school students from various schools for Homi Bhabha Bal Vaigyanik Spardha Pariksha. The response was quite encouraging and the parents were forcing him to start a center at Wardhinee. Keeping the response in mind and the importance of such centre, a coaching center began this year in the month of July. About 18 students are attending the lectures and practices twice a week. Not only the students but their parents are also eager to attend the lecture.
- On the occasion of Gurupournima the volunteer team of Bhagini Nivedita Shakha motivated the wardhikas to write letters to their mother; expressing the feelings for them; as mother is the 1st Guru of every human being. The mothers, after receiving the letter of their own daughter felt very delighted and they expressed their feelings to the shakha volunteers.
- To celebrate Rakhi pournima, the students of Asst. Nursing Course visited two different centers. One group visited a nearby hospital to tie rakhi to the Nurses, Brothers, Ward-Boys as well as Doctors. When they were tying rakhi to the Doctors, one of them asked what sort of "Owalni" (Gift) they would like to have. The instant response from the students was "promise us that neither you will participate and promote the abortion of female foeticide, nor will you allow your colleagues to follow such shameful practice". The Doctors were surprised by this answer but they felt very happy that students of the Nursing Course run by Wardhinee are getting proper training. The other group visited a fire brigade station.

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Whenever there is an emergency situation of fire, flood or other accidents, the brigade works wholeheartedly and does not expect even any praise from the society. But it is the duty of the society to show respect for their role in the society. The group of Nursing Course students tied rakhi to the fire brigade staff. They interviewed them and understood their nature of work, their problems etc.

- Since the year 2000 Wardhinee is running the Coaching Centre for Competitive Examinations; especially for MPSC exams. The results so far are encouraging. However, this year, Wardhinee decided to start a scholarship batch for MPSC. The graduate students from village background are more attracted towards these examinations. Students from socially and economically weaker sections find it very difficult to get coaching because of the exorbitant fee structure. Wardhinee therefore decided to select students from socially/economically weaker sections of the society, through a written test and interviews and run a scholarship batch for them. 130 students appeared to the written test, out of these 90 got selected for interview and 48 from them are selected for this batch.
- Today students of all age group and all faculties, are forced to face a tough competition till they finish their education. This is nothing but a rat race. This life style has created some limitation to personality development. Due to this cut throat competition, the interest towards literature is going down drastically. In order to develop interest towards the Marathi literature at large; and towards the poems, in specific, this year 3 different programs were arranged. Two of them were mainly organized for women wing of the trust. Well known poets like Smt. Hema Lele, Dr.Sangita Barve, Mrunalinii Kanitkar and others presented their poems with the help of well known singers like Smt. Anuradha Marathe, Anjali Kulkarni, Miss.Shruti Vishwakarma, under the titles "Bayanchya Kavita" and "Navya Wata, Navya Goshti". The Third Program was titled "Athwanitil Kavita" and it was presented by a group namely "Kalpak-Pune " These were the poems which every student has read during childhood as a part of their syllabus. The youth who attended the programme were found in a nostalgic mood through out the programme.
- One of the session of the Diwali Camp of Bhag No.3 was a slide show by two persons from Mumbai. They were representing the unique team of 5000 labours who shoulder the responsibility of providing the lunch Tiffin in time to more than five lacs of office staff/workers in Mumbai. Providing lunch Tiffin in time and bringing it back to their homes with maximum 0.1% mistake is a unique example of high management skill, faith, team work and devotion. Their management skill is applauded by reputed Management Institutes; not only in India, but abroad also. The representatives of this famous "Mumbaiche Dabewale" presented a slide show and explained their work methodology and answered the questions asked by the students.
- With the help of a NGO "Bharatiy Stree Shakti", a special programme for girl students of Nivedita Shakha was arranged under the title "Kali Umaltana". It was for girl students of



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adolescent age group. It was to make them understand the problems arising out of physical development during such age group, its psychological effects and how to look at such changes positively. A good session of question and answer was followed after the slide show .

- **Counselling Cell-**
This year all the branches of Integrated Development Centres had sessions on Time Management. Aptitude Test was given to 50 students of 10th Std. before their result was declared. This helped them and their parents to take career decision. Along with this the following topics were covered at Swami Shivanand Shakha, during August to December'11.

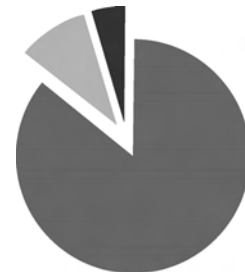
Result of Proper Counseling

An Appeal to support the expansion plan

The society at large expects that every year the trust should reach to more & more needy students/women in the society. Keeping this expectation in mind, expansion of ongoing projects/activities is undertaken regularly. However, at certain times, the trust needs to take a great leap, which would expand the activities faster than the normal pace.

Founder President Late Purushottambhai Shroff and his daughter Mrs.Surukha Mashruwala, donated one acre of land to 'Swa'-Roopwardhinee in the year 2007. The founder of the trust Late Shri.Kishabhau Patwardhan and the Founder President Late Purushottambhai Shroff had a dream to start a multifaceted training institute for needy women. Both of them had strongly canvassed till their last breath to construct a building at Charholi for this training institute.

Since 1990, the trust is running short duration courses like Asstt. Nursing Course, Tailoring etc. in Pune, for needy women. Through this humble endeavour, till now, the trust has helped more than 1600 needy women to become self reliant. With the expansion plan at Charholi, the trust can reach to quite a big number of needy women from urban and rural areas. The trust has passed a resolution to start a multifaceted training institute with residential facility at Charholi. Alongwith Nursing Course the trust wishes to run courses in Fashion Designing, Yoga Training, Montessori Teachers Training etc.

The trust has already appointed M/s.Rajeev Vishwasrao as its Architects, who have submitted the construction plan to Pimpri Chinchwad Corporation, for their necessary approval. The total project cost would reach up to Rs.6.00 Crore. However, the trust has a plan to have this construction project in phases. In the first phase the trust wishes to construct Ground + 2 floors, where the above referred courses shall be run. The first phase would cost app. Rs.3.50 Cr. After taking into consideration the need for further expansion, the remaining part of the bldg. would be completed.
